Did You Know?

<u>Seasons</u> occur because Earth's axis is tilted as it <u>orbits</u> the Sun. During winter in the Northern Hemisphere, the axis is tilted away from the <u>Sun</u>, causing sunlight to <u>strike</u> at a lower <u>angle</u>. This results in the sunlight <u>being</u> <u>more spread</u> out, leading to cooler temperatures and shorter <u>days</u>. Meanwhile, in the Southern Hemisphere, the Earth is tilted toward the Sun, so sunlight <u>hits</u> more directly, bringing warmer temperatures and longer day – marking summer in that region.
